Pigs, goats, cows, reindeer, alpacas, poultry including chickens, ducks, ponies, wallabies, meerkats, cows, donkey and small furry critters in the small animal zone such as rabbits, guinea pigs, reptiles, tortoise.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

You are no doubt aware that visits to a farm do carry a very small but real risk of infections to humans. By following simple hygiene procedures, as you would with your own pet, teachers and parents should have, however, no reason to worry. We believe the benefits of such a visit far outweigh any reason to stay away.

Willow Tree Farm prides itself on its cleanliness and its excellent hand washing facilities located in every animal area. It is advisable to bring a spare pair of shoes, allowing for dirty footwear to be taken home in a disposable plastic bag.

USE YOUR FREE ADMISSION

Before your visit to help you plan and complete a health and safety risk assessment.



BEFORE YOUR VISIT:

Parents and pupils will benefit from being notified in advance of the following:

- Advice on what the children should wear. We have little shade in the summer, and can get very muddy in the winter.
- A spare pair of shoes and a plastic bag.
- A reminder that all existing cuts and abrasions should be covered before the visit with something like a plaster.

DURING YOUR VISIT:

✓ Food cannot be eaten in the animal enclosure areas. Food can only be eaten in designated picnic areas, the restaurant or your school meeting area.

✓ After contact with animals (and before children eat their lunch), please ensure that their hands are washed with soap and dried properly.

✓ Young children should have adult supervision to ensure that hands are washed properly.

✓ When children are petting or feeding the animals, please warn them not the place their face or mouth against the animal's or put their hands in the animal's mouth.

Before you depart, please ensure all children wash their hands thoroughly one last time.

SPECIAL NEEDS FACILITIES

We pride ourselves on being an accessible site. From extra wide paths to a changing places toilet with hoist system in place, getting round shouldn't be a problem.

Our changing places offer we have a purposebuilt disabled toilet and changing area, with a bed and lift mechanism suitable for adults, and a height adjustable sink, perfect for wheelchair users. Our helpful staff are on hand to discuss any special requirements you may have! CALL US ON 01623 748808

WILLOW TREE FARM PARK SCHOOL GROUP BOOKINGS Terms and Conditions

Payment and Booking:

- School Group visits are only available Monday-Friday, term times as per NCC, DCC education time table.
- A non-refundable deposit is required to secure the booking and will be deducted from the final cost of your visit. For groups / schools must buy their tickets online.
- Changes to the date of your visit will be accommodated as far as possible but cannot be guaranteed.
- The group booking rate of £8.20 per child is for groups of 15 or more children that have booked in advance. You will be entitled to 1 adult free for every 5 children that you pay for. This will not be rounded up e.g. if you bring 34 children you will be entitled to 6 free adults and not 7. Additional adults will be charged £3.50. Disabled groups get 1 complementary adult carer per paying qualifying child.
- Full payment for your visit is due before the visit starts, either on or before the date of your visit. Payment can be made on our website when booking your tickets

On the day:

- Please arrive 15 minutes before your allocated arrival time and report to the cafe to pay the balance if still outstanding, and to receive wristbands for your free adults. Your guide (if you have one booked in advance) will meet you and talk to your group about health and safety.
- Please do not leave valuables here as Willow Tree Farm cannot be held responsible for your property as the lunch area will not be locked.
- You will be allocated 30 minutes for using the lunch area. Please be aware that another group may be using this space immediately before or after your group, so please leave the room as you would wish to find it and place all rubbish in the bins provided. Please keep to your allocated times. If the weather is fine, you are welcome to use the outside picnic area for lunch instead.
- Willow tree farm reserves the right to make last-minute changes to your itinerary, but wherever possible will endeavour not to change this without informing you beforehand. Please ensure that all the adults in your group have a copy of your itinerary and a map of the farm. Please turn up to your activity at the correct time and try not to disturb other groups who may have an activity booked before you.
- Your visit will go ahead whatever the weather, but please come dressed according to the weather conditions as although part of the attraction is under cover, many of the animals will be in paddocks outside.
- The adults will be responsible for the supervision of children and for ensuring that the children wash their hands thoroughly with soap and warm water after touching the animals. They should also ensure that they do not put their hands in their mouths and only eat and drink in the designated areas.

Cancellations and changes to the Group Booking:

- The deposit paid at the time of booking is non refundable if the visit is cancelled, irrespective of the notice given.
- In the event of there being a reduction in the number of children visiting, the farm must be notified as soon as possible so that places on the booked activities can be offered to other groups.
- In the event of there being an increase in the number of children visiting, the farm must be notified as soon as possible.
- In the event of Willow Tree Farm having to cancel your visit due to unforeseen circumstances, an alternative date will be offered. This only happens in instances beyond our control e.g. Closure of the farm due to adverse weather or animal health etc.
